**OAK:** (OL22) SU 412062 OAK Road CP Dibden Purlieu behind St Andrew's Church

**CAR SHARING** is encouraged. Passengers should expect to pay about 5p per mile each towards running cost

**PICNIC LUNCHES** It is assumed that walkers will take Picnic Lunches on longer walks (Wednesdays, Thursdays and Sundays)

**EVENING WALKS** After the walk you can meet up at the pub for a drink / meal

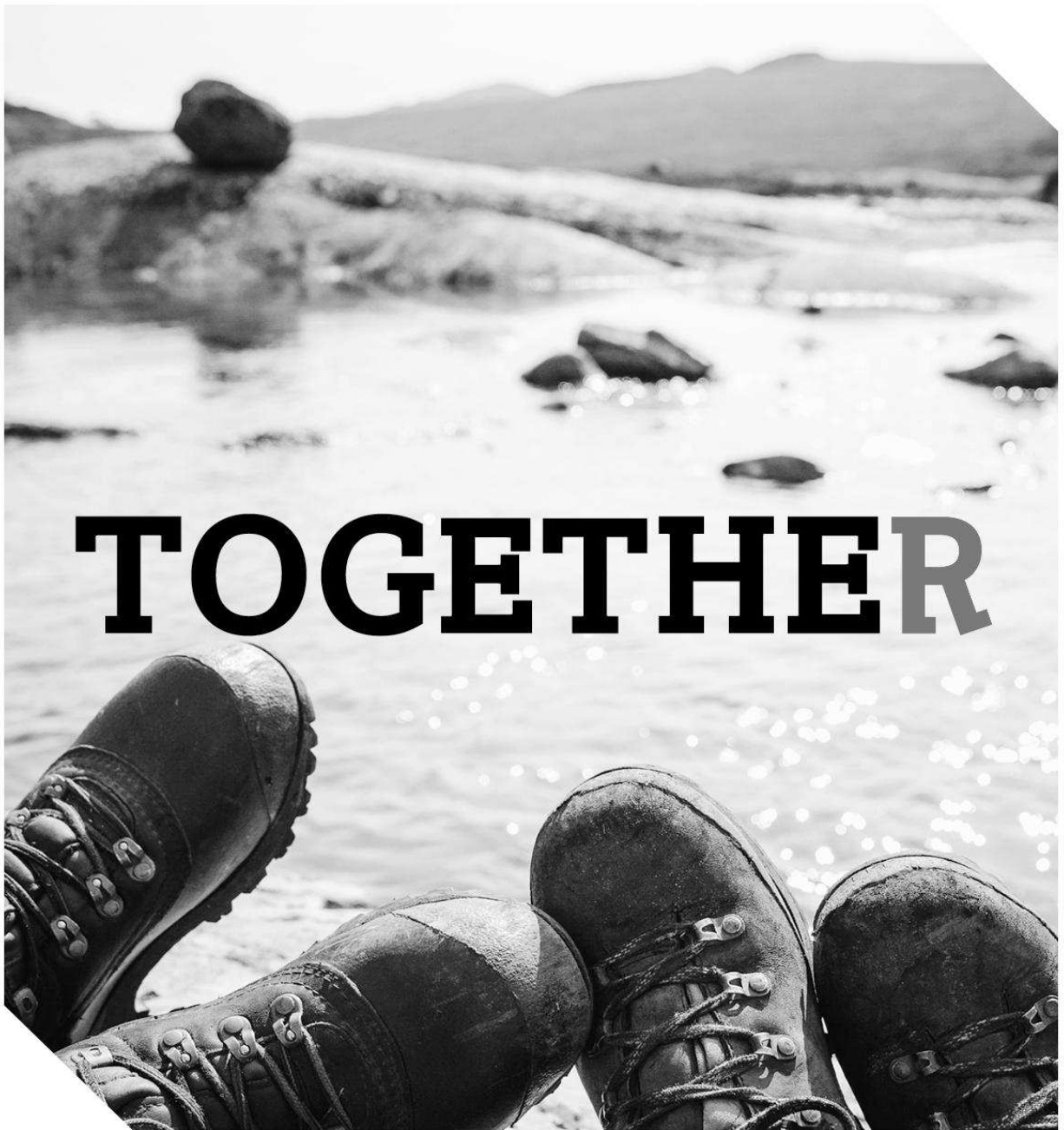
